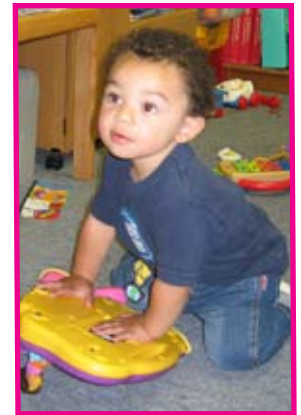
Queridos Amigos de SPIN:

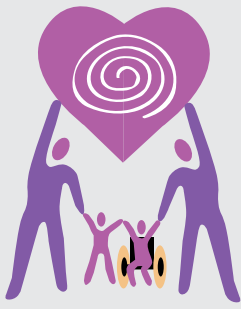

She has been looking for a volunteer opportunity in Santa Cruz; SPIN seemed like a good fit. She is an attorney and works in family law; she has her own firm and works 4 days a week. She also has another daughter, age 3.

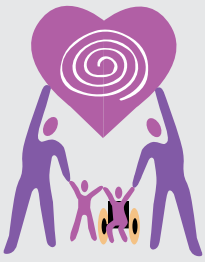
